This study aims to obtain an overview of the extent of the correlation between Eye and Hand Coordination to Volleyball's Overhand Passing Skills in Extracurricular at SMA Negeri 2 of Central Bengkulu. In accordance with the problems and research objectives, this study used a correlation method, namely correlation analysis techniques with product moment statistics, this study used a sample of 17 athletes from SMA Negeri 2 of Central Bengkulu who were taken with purposive sampling technique. The results of the data obtained from the correlation between eye and hand coordination on Volleyball's Overhand Passing Skills, obtained t<sub>count</sub> = 0.888> r<sub>table</sub> = 0.482 at the significance level  $\alpha$  = 0.05. Thus, Ha which says there is a significant correlation between eye and hand coordination on volleyball's overhand passing skills is accepted, consequently H0 is rejected. Thus it can be concluded that there is a significant correlation between eye and hand coordination and the Volleyball's Overhand Passing Skills in extracurricular students of SMA Negeri 2 of Central Bengkulu with a value of  $r_{x,y} = 0.888 > r_{(0.05)(15)} = 0.482$ .
