ABSTRACT

This research aims to find out an overview of the implementation of the Republic of Indonesia Prosecutor's Office Management Information System Policy Phase II (SIMKARI II) at Bengkulu Prosecutor's Office. The research method used is qualitative research and data collection techniques through observation, interviews, and documentation. In this analysis method, Edward III (Subarsono, 2011) uses the approach, saying that policy implementation is influenced by four variables, namely 1. Communication, Resources, Disposition and Bureaucratic Structure. The results show that communication in terms of work carried out by Bengkulu Prosecutor's Office between leaders and subordinates is part of the process of transferring information, facts, and understanding to employees which can be interpreted according to the desired goals, the resources of the office always provide the best service to the community in terms of providing information about ongoing criminal cases, the disposition at the office is committed, honest and has a democratic nature by the legal rules and norms in force in the Republic of Indonesia and the bureaucratic structure that exists at Bengkulu Prosecutor's Office, is quite influential on the continuity of implementation in assigned tasks by Standard Operating Procedures (SOP).
